

Career Traineeship in Hospitality

MSLETB in conjunction with Hoteliers in the Northwest and West are launching a new and exciting initiative to develop real career paths in the Hospitality and Tourism Sector.

What is a Career Traineeship?

A Career Traineeship is a Work Based Training model developed in conjunction with employers. A significant amount of the course is delivered in the Workplace with a host/sponsor Hotelier. Course duration is 50 Weeks.

What are the benefits for you?

- You receive certified and accredited specific training in a broad based Tourism/Hospitality programme.
- The Programme is certified at FETAC/QQI Level 5 Major Award in Hospitality Operations.
- Working closely with a host/sponsor Hotel significantly increases your prospects of employment.
- A Major level 5 Award is eligible for up to 400 CAO points (FETAC/QQI Major level 5 distinction = 400 Leaving Certificate Points)



Who is eligible?

Individuals on the live register can apply for the programme. For full eligibility criteria and to register for the programme please contact your local Intreo Office.

Requirements;

- Applicants must secure a place in one of the participating Hotels for the Work Based Learning elements of this Programme. See www.sligotrainingcentre.ie - FAQs- National Career Traineeship in Hospitality.
- Applicants must have a level 4 award or equivalent.
- Basic numeracy and literacy is essential.
- Applicants must have good written and oral English language skills.
- A screening process will be conducted in partnership with the Host Hoteliers.
